light to the world.

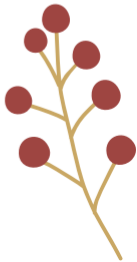

God promised Mary that she would have a baby named Jesus. Mary said “nothing is impossible with God!”

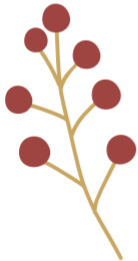

love him.



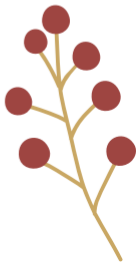

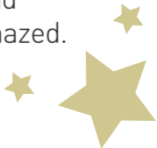
